- Brevini Japan Co., Ltd.** – One of branches of Brevini providing power transmission, hydraulic and electronic solutions for marine, industrial machineries, agriculture, mobile and high torque gear boxes.
- Najico Spicer Co., Ltd.** – A joint venture company between Dana Holding Corporation and Nakamura Jico Co., Ltd., that supports customers by manufacturing industrial propshafts, universal joints, and heat exchangers in Japan.
